Grievance Redressal Mechanism Details

Grievance Redressal Mechanism. The mechanism of redressing students' grievances is a significant worth mentioning practice prevailing in the department. Although we were redressing students' grievances in the past too, but we used to know their grievances through informal chat with the students. The second source was indirect discussion/chat with the teaching/non-teaching staff of the department as well of the composite college. Yet another source was the staff of the practicing schools with whom the students were more comfortable to share their problems. However, in this process the students were a bit hesitant to express their grievances due to fear of revealing their names. In order to overcome this factor of hesitation we thought of evolving a system with the following objectives:

- To optimize the use of physical resources for all-round development of prospective teachers.
- To create a student friendly, conducive teaching-learning environment in the department.
- To create an environment of respect and rapport by way of

	<p>environment of respect and rapport by way of encouraging students' participation in teaching-learning process. • To make the students feel that they are part and partial of us and their opinions have a value. • To make the students feel valued and comfortable during their stay in the department. • To create an atmosphere where the students feel free to express their grievances/views in a healthy fashion. It is our firm belief that in any teaching-learning situation one essential skill on the part of the teacher is to maintain respect and rapport in his class room by encouraging students' participation in the teaching – learning process. Teacher's behavioral pattern is critical to build up the overall tone of the class where the teacher is successful in communicating the message to his students that he is interested in their upcoming and that their opinion has a value for him. This concept, if extended to the institution as a whole, the institution shall be successful in developing a "culture for learning", where there exist an atmosphere of respect and rapport for each other. THE PREVAILING PRACTICE: We have two 'Drop Boxes' in the department, one outside the girls' common room and another in the corridor. The instructions read as: Dear trainees! Stop a while, I am here to help you! And make your stay comfortable and pleasurable in the campus. If you have any grievance/problem during your stay in the campus, simply write it on a piece of paper and drop it here. It would be highly appreciable if you could suggest a possible Solution /suggestion too. P.S. You need not write your name on the paper. Even if you wish to write it, be assured, in any condition Your name shall not be disclosed to anyone. This box will be opened on every Saturday by the Principal/Head of the faculty only</p>
